### **Product description**

Ultramid® A 221 Natural is an unfilled polyamide 66, for injection moulding, with a special crystallizing agent, for fast cycles. This grade offers a good combination between primary properties of the unreinforced polyamide 66 and processing properties leading to increase deproductivity. These performances are associated with excellent dimensional stability and residual parts. good rigidity of moulded parts.

## **Injection Notes**

The material is supplied in airtight bags, ready for use. In case that the virgin material has absorbed moisture, it must be dried with a dehumidified air drying equipment, dew point mini -20°C. Recommended time 2-4h.

- Injection Advice:
   For unfilled polyamides, BASF SE recommends the use of high alloy steel with a low chromium content. For example: X38CrMoV5-1 (EN Norm) - 1.2367 /1.2343 (DIN Norm). In the case of high requirements on surface quality a mould temperature of up to 120°C can be considered.

  • The processing parameters like processing temperatures are a recommendation and can be adjusted in function of
- injection machine size, part geometry / design.
