LINEAR LOW DENSITY POLYETHYLENE BLOWN FILM GRADE

HP I 9010 is a Linear Low Density Polyethylene (LLDPE), with optimum levels of antioxidants, anti blocking agents and slip additives. The grade is designed to make blown film for heavy duty applications and liquid packaging, where good toughness, impact and tear resistance are desired.

Storage Recommendations
